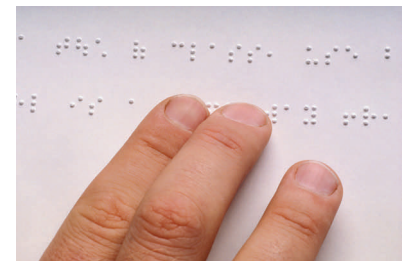

What is the Exemption?

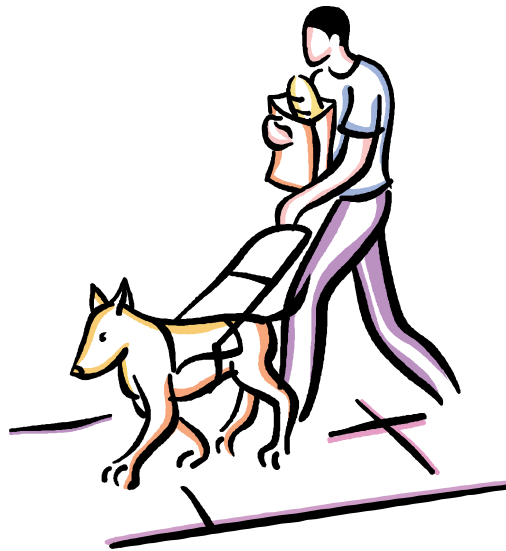
How Do I Qualify?

The Blind Exemption is a property tax relief program for residents that are visually impaired. The exemption reduces the taxable value of the real estate of qualifying residents. To qualify:

You or your spouse must be determined to be legally blind by the blind services program, bureau of vocational rehabilitation, department of education of the State of New Hampshire.

What is the Amount of Exemption?

The amount of exemption is currently set at \$21,000.



How does this reduce my taxes?

An exemption reduces the taxable value of your real estate. For example:

Without Exemption

LAND VALUE	\$65,000
BUILDING VALUE	\$130,000
TOTAL ASSESSMENT	\$195,000
TAX RATE	\$20.77
TAXES	\$4,050

With Exemption

LAND VALUE	\$65,000
BUILDING VALUE	\$130,000
TOTAL ASSESSMENT	\$195,000
LESS EXEMPTION	\$21,000
NET ASSESSMENT	\$174,000
TAX RATE	\$20.77
TAXES	\$3,614
SAVINGS	\$436
