What is the Tax Credit?

How Do I Qualify?

The Veterans' Tax Credit is a program for Lebanon's veterans and/or their spouses. The tax credit reduces the total tax owed by the credit amount.

Other tax credit and exemption programs exist for veterans with permanent and total disabilities, for surviving spouses of residents killed in action and for paraplegic or quadriplegic veterans. To qualify:

1. You or your spouse must be an honorably discharged veteran with 90 days active duty service, or be the surviving spouse of a veteran.

- A surviving spouse receives the credit so long as the spouse does not re-marry.

2. You must be a resident of the State of New Hampshire for at least one year prior to April 1 in the year of

application.

3. Your real estate must be your permanent place of residence. You may only claim one property as your permanent place of residence.

4. You must have served in a qualifying war or armed conflict.

- World War I
 - √ 04/06/17 - 11/11/18 extended to 04/01/20 for service in Russia with certain provisions.
- World War II 12/07/41 - 12/31/46
- Korean Conflict 06/25/50 - 01/31/55
- Vietnam Conflict
 - √ 12/22/61 - 05/07/75
 - √ If between 07/01/58 and 12/22/61 must have earned the Vietnam Service Medal or the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.
- Persian Gulf War
 - √ 08/02/90 and the date thereafter prescribed by Presidential Proclamation or by law.
- Any Other Armed Conflict
 - √ Earned an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal or Theater of Operations Medal since 05/08/75.

What is the Amount of Tax Credit?

The Tax Credit is \$100 and is apportioned at \$50 for each semi-annual tax bill.

How does this reduce my taxes?

A tax credit reduces the tax amount due on your real estate. For example:

LAND VALUE	\$30,000
BUILDING VALUE	\$50,000
TOTAL ASSESSMENT	\$80,000
TAX RATE	\$21.21
TAXES	\$1,272.60
TAX CREDIT	\$100.00
BALANCE DUE	\$1,172.60
